➤ **Work period: June 02 – 12, 2026**

➤ **Argument:**

No educational reform becomes functional in the absence of **competent and visionary educational management**. The school principal, the school inspector, the training program coordinator, the project coordinator, all of them are, in equal measure, decision-makers and agents of organizational culture. **Instructional leadership practices**, delegation of responsibility, building professional learning communities (**Professional Learning Communities**) and leveraging data in decision-making represent essential levers through which **pedagogical innovation becomes possible and sustainable at the institutional level**.

Recent research in the field of *educational management highlights that leadership style directly influences school climate, teacher motivation, and ultimately student performance* (Leithwood et al., 2020; Day et al., 2016). *Effective school management does not manage resources, but cultivates human capital, generates shared vision, and creates the conditions in which innovation can flourish organically, not through bureaucratic coercion or conformity.*

➤ **Thematic directions:**

The papers proposed for publication are invited to explore, among others:

- *models of curricular and didactic innovation adapted to the requirements of the 21st century;*
- *effective school management practices in contexts of diversity and change;*

- *quality assurance systems and tools in pre-university and university education;*
- *integration of digital technology as a factor of innovation and quality;*
- *continuous training of teaching staff from the perspective of sustainable professional development;*
- *European projects (Erasmus+, eTwinning, Horizon) as laboratories of innovation and transfer of good practices;*
- *assessment of the impact of educational reforms through qualitative and quantitative tools.*
- **Target group:** teaching staff/teaching staff with management functions/teaching staff with guidance and control functions/school counselors/school psychologists.
- **Requirements for writing scientific articles:**
 - **Title** — typed in capital letters, centered, at the top of the page;
 - **Information about the author (position, name, surname, educational institution)** — typed at one interval after the title, right-aligned;
 - **Abstract/summary** — up to 100 words, written in Romanian and English/French;
 - **Keywords** — up to 7 terms/expressions;
 - **Text** — 2-5 pages, typed in A4 format, Times New Roman font, font size 12, line spacing 1.5;
 - **Materials will be accompanied by a bibliography written according to APA standards.**

Responsibility for the content of the works lies with the authors.

Each participant will attach only one work to the form.

➤ **Deadline:**

- The participation form must be completed by **May 22, 2026**.
- Participation certificates will be sent to the participants' email addresses in **July 2026**.
- Scientific papers will be published in a volume entitled: "**Quality Educational Management - Innovation and Excellence in the Education System**", which will be sent to the participants' email addresses in **July 2026**.
